| 7  | House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives        |  |  |
| 8  | and six members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.      |  |  |
| 9  | The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint a cochair, and the President   |  |  |
| 10 | Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint a cochair for the Committee.                     |  |  |
| 11 | The Committee, while in the discharge of its official duties, may exercise all           |  |  |
| 12 | powers provided for under G.S. 120-19 and G.S. 120-19.1 through G.S. 120-19.4. The       |  |  |
