A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ADOPTING THE CALDWELL COUNTY BLACKBERRY FESTIVAL AS  
THE OFFICIAL BLACKBERRY FESTIVAL OF THE STATE OF NORTH  
CAROLINA.

Whereas, blackberries and blackberry products have served as a part of the  
heritage of Caldwell County for years; and

Whereas, to celebrate this tradition, an annual Caldwell County Blackberry  
Festival began in July of 2001; and

Whereas, the original festival was held at the J.E. Broyhill Park, a small  
municipal park in Lenoir, with the mission of promoting agricultural tourism and local  
traditional music and bringing together the citizens from Lenoir and surrounding  
communities; and

Whereas, the Caldwell County Blackberry Festival has grown from 20  
vendors and 1,000 participants to 150 vendors and 10,000 visitors in six years; and

Whereas, the festival has become an important marketing and promotional  
tool for Lenoir, Caldwell County, and North Carolina; and

Whereas, the Caldwell County Blackberry Festival should be adopted as the  
official blackberry festival of the State of North Carolina; Now, therefore,  
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a  
new section to read:

**"§ 145-27. State blackberry festival.**

**The Caldwell County Blackberry Festival is adopted as the official blackberry  
festival of the State of North Carolina."**

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
