A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CENTER FOR WOMEN'S HEALTH  
RESEARCH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL  
HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million two hundred  
thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one million  
two hundred thousand (\$1,200,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be  
allocated to the Center for Women's Health Research at the University of North  
Carolina at Chapel Hill and shall be used for one and one-half FTEs for statewide  
coordination, a director for the new Scholars Program; three FTEs for project  
development; salary support for directors, leading researchers, and educators;  
coordination of events; an innovation pilot project, and other stipends, tuition, and staff.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
