| 7  | G.S. 90-95(a)(1) on property that is a public park or within 300 feet of |   |
| 8  | the boundary of real property that is a public park shall be punished as |   |
| 9  |  | a Class E felon. For purposes of this subdivision, the transfer of less           |
| 10 |  | than five grams of marijuana for no remuneration shall not constitute a           |
| 11 |  | delivery in violation of G.S. 90-95(a)(1)."                                       |
| 12 | SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to   |   |
