A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REBUILD THE MAIN SHELTER AT  
THE TREASURE POINT 4-H YOUTH CAMP IN CAMDEN COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Camden County 4-H and Youth Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be used in rebuilding the log cabin at the Treasure Point 4-H and Youth Camp. This facility had served as the camp's main shelter, provided meeting space, and housed equipment before it was destroyed by a fire.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
