	The first two thousand dollars (\$2,000) of the appraised value of one motor vehicle owned by an individual who is at least 65 years of age and who has an income of not more than the income eligibility limit specified in G.S. 105-277.1."
SECTION 2. This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years	
beginning on or after July 1, 2008.
