14 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
15 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General H	Fund to the
16 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one million dollars	(\$1,000,000)
17 for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000),000) for the
18 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated to the UNC School	of Medicine,
19 Department of Psychiatry, for the design and implementation of ed	ducation and
20 screening programs to identify resources for the treatment of women	who develop
21 postpartum depression. These funds may be used for salaries, education	nal materials,
22 and screening instruments. The UNC School of Medicine, Department o	of Psychiatry,
23 shall work with the Department of Health and Human Services, the Sta	tate Board of
24 Medical Examiners, the State Board of Nursing, and Area Health Educa	ation Centers
25 (AHEC) to implement the education and screening programs.	
26 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
