SECTION 1. G.S. 105-277.12 reads as rewritten:

	shows, and other public interest functions.		
((3) It is used only occasionally for other purposes.		
(4	(4) It is used by the owner for a purpose other than the pr	roduction of	
	income.		
(b) A	Antique airplanes are designated a special class of property unde	er Article V,	
Sec. 2(2) of the North Carolina Constitution and shall be assessed for taxation in			
accordance with this section. An antique airplane shall be assessed at the lower of its			
true value or five thousand dollars (\$5,000)."			

SECTION 2. This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years

beginning on or after July 1, 2007.
