The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Healthy	
Start Foundation, Inc., the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2008-2009	
fiscal year.	These funds shall be allocated as a grant-in-aid to the North Carolina
Healthy Start Foundation to:	
(1	Increase involvement and awareness of infant mortality-related issues among key statewide, health-related, professional organizations, and
(2	Increase infant mortality and morbidity awareness and adoption of risk reduction strategies and resources in some of the State's most at-risk
	geographic areas.
