A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SCHOOL-BASED AND
2 SCHOOL-LINKED ADOLESCENT HEALTH CARE CENTERS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
6 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three
7 hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These
8 funds shall be used for the purpose of sustaining the centers and assisting centers that
9 have been experiencing growth in caseloads. The Division shall allocate these funds to
10 school-based and school-linked adolescent health centers that have been credentialed by
11 the State, are in the process of being credentialed, or are providing high quality services
12 in a limited capacity.

13 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
14 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of two
15 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds
16 shall be used to provide start-up grants for five new school health centers in areas of the
17 State where there are critical needs.

18 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
