A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE MATTHEWS AND MINT HILL  
DEPARTMENTS FOR GANG VIOLENCE AND CRIME PREVENTION  
EFFORTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Matthews the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to support the Town's police department in its effort to prevent gang violence and other crimes.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Mint Hill the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to support the Town's police department in its effort to prevent gang violence and other crimes.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
