A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROMOTE THE PRESERVATION AND REHABILITATION OF THE
HISTORIC BORDEN MILL COMPLEX IN GOLDSBORO BY DIRECTING THE
NORTH CAROLINA RAILROAD TO TRANSFER MILL BUILDING
ENCROACHMENTS FOR USE IN THE HISTORIC MILL REHABILITATION
PROJECT, AND BY PROHIBITING THE RAILROAD FROM REMOVING OR
DEMOLISHING ANY HISTORIC MILL BUILDING IN GOLDSBORO THAT
ENCROACHES ON ITS RIGHT-OF-WAY.

9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

10 **SECTION 1.** The Board of Directors of the North Carolina Railroad 11 Company shall transfer by permanent easement or sale property within its corridor that 12 is occupied by structures of the historic Borden Manufacturing Company complex in 13 Goldsboro for fair market value for use in the restoration and rehabilitation of the site. 14 Any transfer of property to the Borden site project developer shall be contingent on 15 completion of the project within five years from the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. The North Carolina Railroad Company shall not remove or
 demolish any structure in Goldsboro that is listed on the National Register of Historic
 Places, is located within its right-of-way, and is part of an historic mill complex.

19 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
