5 **SECTION 4.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge 6 for District 13 authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the 7 2010 election for an four-year term commencing January 1, 2011.

SECTION 5. G.S. 7A-133(b2) reads as rewritten:

9 "(b2) The qualified voters of District Court District 13 shall elect all six-seven 10 judges established for the District in subsection (a) of this section, but only persons who 11 reside in Bladen County may be candidates for one of those judgeships, only persons 12 who reside in Columbus County may be candidates for one of those judgeships, and 13 only persons who reside in Brunswick County may be candidates for two three of those 14 judgeships. The district court judgeship established for residents of Bladen County by 15 this subsection shall be the judgeship currently held by Judge Phillips, who resides in 16 Bladen County. The district court judgeship established for residents of Columbus 17 County by this subsection shall be the judgeship currently held by Judge Jolly, who 18 resides in Columbus County. The district court judgeships established for residents of 19 Brunswick County by this subsection shall be the judgeships currently held by Judge 20 Barefoot and Judge Warren, who reside in Brunswick County. County, and the 21 additional judgeship effective January 15, 2009. Those judges' successors shall be 22 elected for four-year terms in the 2008 general election. Candidates for the remaining 23 judgeships in District 13 may be residents of any county within the district."

SECTION 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of six hundred forty-seven thousand eight hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$647,897) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to establish the additional resident superior court judge established for District 13A in this act, the additional district court judge established for District 13B in this act, an additional judicial assistant position for Superior Court District 13B, and five new magistrate positions for Brunswick County.

30 **SECTION 7.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial 31 Department the sum of two hundred eighty-one thousand seventy-nine dollars 32 (\$281,079) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to establish five new probation officers to 33 serve Bladen, Brunswick, and Columbus Counties. These funds shall be used to 34 establish two new intake officer positions, two probation officer II positions, and one 35 surveillance officer position.

36 **SECTION 8.** Sections 1 through 4 become effective January 15, 2009. The 37 remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
