1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO ADD PSEUDOEPHEDRINE TO THE LIST OF SCHEDULE V
3 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 90-93(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) This schedule includes the controlled substances listed or to be listed by
7 whatever official name, common or usual name, chemical name, or trade name
8 designated. In determining that a substance comes within this schedule, the Commission
9 shall find: a low potential for abuse relative to the substances listed in Schedule IV of
10 this Article; currently accepted medical use in the United States; and limited physical or
11 psychological dependence relative to the substances listed in Schedule IV of this
12 Article. The following controlled substances are included in this schedule:

13 (1) Any compound, mixture or preparation containing any of the
14 following limited quantities of narcotic drugs or salts thereof, which
15 shall include one or more nonnarcotic active medicinal ingredients in
16 sufficient proportion to confer upon the compound, mixture, or
17 preparation valuable medicinal qualities other than those possessed by
18 the narcotic alone:

- 19 a. Not more than 200 milligrams of codeine or any of its salts per
20 100 milliliters or per 100 grams.
- 21 b. Not more than 100 milligrams of dihydrocodeine or any of its
22 salts per 100 milliliters or per 100 grams.
- 23 c. Not more than 100 milligrams of ethylmorphine or any of its
24 salts per 100 milliliters or per 100 grams.
- 25 d. Not more than 2.5 milligrams of diphenoxylate and not less
26 than 25 micrograms of atropine sulfate per dosage unit.
- 27 e. Not more than 100 milligrams of opium per 100 milliliters or
28 per 100 grams.
