## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE REVENUE LAWS STUDY COMMITTEE TO 3 DETERMINE DIFFERENT METHOD FOR DISTRIBUTING А THE 4 FRANCHISE TAX ON ELECTRIC POWER COMPANIES IN ORDER TO 5 SIMPLIFY THE DISTRIBUTION, REDUCE THE ADMINISTRATIVE BURDEN 6 ASSOCIATED WITH THE DISTRIBUTION, AND PREVENT ERRORS IN THE 7 DISTRIBUTION.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** The General Assembly finds that the current distribution to 10 cities under G.S. 105-116.1 of part of the franchise tax on electric power companies 11 imposes unnecessary administrative burdens on the cities, the power companies, and the Department of Revenue and results in numerous errors in the distribution. The Revenue 12 13 Laws Study Committee is directed to recommend a method of distributing this revenue 14 to the cities on the basis of a formula that uses factors such as population and percentage share of prior distributions rather than service inside constantly changing city 15 16 boundaries. The Committee must consult with the League of Municipalities and the 17 Department of Revenue in developing a recommendation. The Committee must include its recommendation on a distribution method it its report to the 2008 Regular Session of 18 19 the 2007 General Assembly. **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 20
