Short Title: Funds for Ocracoke Fishing Facility. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OCRACOKE FOUNDATION, INC.,
A NONPROFIT CORPORATION, FOR THE LAST COMMERCIAL FISHING
FACILITY IN OCRACOKE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Ocracoke Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be used for the renovation and expansion of the South Point Market, the last commercial fishing facility in Ocracoke. The funds may also be used for equipment and marketing of the facility.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
