SENATE BILL 1414

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO NORTH CAROLINA STATE
UNIVERSITY FOR THE ENGINEERING SCHOOL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) in recurring funds and the sum of seventeen million dollars (\$17,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2007-2008 fiscal year, the sum of fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) in recurring funds and the sum of seventeen million dollars (\$17,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2008-2009 fiscal year for the engineering school at North Carolina State University. The funds shall be used to hire new faculty and staff and construct additional space at the engineering school to assist the school in becoming nationally competitive.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
