Short Title: Motor Fuels Tax Holiday. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SUMMER MOTOR FUELS TAX HOLIDAY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 36C of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 105-449.81A. Excise tax holiday.

(a) The tax imposed by this Article shall not apply to motor fuels supplied or imported between July 1 and August 31.

(b) Sunset. – This section is repealed effective July 1, 2010."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008, and applies to motor fuel purchased on or after that date.
