Assembly of North Carolina enacts: ECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North otechnology Center, Inc., the sum of one million two hundred fifty thousand 250,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to extend existing Center grant at support biotechnology research, education, and training. These funds cated as follows: (1) \$800,000 to augment the Faculty Recruitment Grant (FRG) program, which funds part of faculty start-up packages and builds foundational biotechnology research capacity at North Carolina universities. (2) \$450,000 to expand biotechnology education grants, workshops, and K-12 teacher support across the State, to define measures for educators necessary to shape workforce training programs, and to launch new programs to enhance university graduates' competitiveness for biotechnology jobs. ECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
