SENATE BILL 290

Short Title: Amend Speeding to Elude Arrest Statute. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE SEIZURE OF ANY VEHICLE USED TO FELONIOUSLY
FLEE OR FELONIOUSLY ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE A LAW ENFORCEMENT
OFFICER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE OFFICER'S OFFICIAL DUTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-141.5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"**§ 20-141.5. Speeding to elude arrest.**

...

(b2) Any vehicle involved in a violation of subsection (a) of this section, if
subsections (b) or (b1) are applicable to the offense, shall be declared contraband and
subject to seizure and summary forfeiture to the State.

..."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.
