A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE ISSUANCE OF ABC
PERMITS TO RESIDENTIAL PRIVATE CLUBS AND SPORTS CLUBS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 1.1 of S.L. 2001-130 reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 1.1.** This act does not apply in Burke, Lincoln, Harnett, Davie, Graham,
Swain, Yancey, and McDowell Counties."

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall not apply to permits that have been
issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission in Burke County prior to the
passage of this act. This act shall not affect the ability of the current holders of
Residential Private Club or Sports Club permits in Burke County to continue operation.
This act shall not prevent the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission from issuing a
new Private Residential Club or Sports Club permit to a location that currently holds the
appropriate permit if a new applicant meets all required criteria to hold the permit
applied for under the provisions of Chapter 18B of the General Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
