A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE DEER SEASONS AND REMOVE BAG LIMITS ON 3 DEER IN ORDER TO REDUCE THE DEER POPULATION IN THE STATE. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 113-291.2 or any other 6 provision of law, beginning with the 2007 hunting seasons, the Wildlife Resources Commission shall extend each of the seasons for taking deer with guns by opening the 7 8 season one week earlier and closing it one week later than previously established by rule 9 of the Commission. The Commission may adjust the bow and arrow and muzzle-loading seasons in its discretion in order to accommodate for the lengthening of 10 11 the gun seasons. 12 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 113-291.2 or any other provision of law, there shall be no bag limits during any deer season established by the 13 14 Wildlife Resources Commission. 15 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and expires January 16 1, 2009.
