A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE JEWISH HERITAGE FOUNDATION
OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ASSIST THE ORGANIZATION IN PRODUCING A
HERITAGE DOCUMENTARY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Jewish
Heritage Foundation of North Carolina, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred
fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to assist the organization
in producing its heritage project, "Down Home: Jewish Life in North Carolina."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
