A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO VARIOUS COUNTIES IN WESTERN
NORTH CAROLINA FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NARTEST SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Cherokee County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence quickly.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Clay County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence quickly.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Graham County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence quickly.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Haywood County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence quickly.

SECTION 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Jackson County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence quickly.

SECTION 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Macon County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence quickly.

SECTION 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Swain County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence quickly.

1 **SECTION 8.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Transylvania
2 County the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to
3 purchase a NarTest system to enable the sheriff's department to analyze drug evidence
4 quickly.

5 **SECTION 9.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
