BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 2589 amends G.S. 105-164.3 to eliminate the speed limit for mopeds which was previously set at 30 miles per hour. The definition of a moped is expanded to include motors that have a piston displacement of up to 150 cubic centimeters. The bill also requires a drivers license for moped operators under the age of 18. Individuals 18 years of age and older may operate a moped without a drivers license.

The NC Division of Motor Vehicles estimates there will be no fiscal impact as a result of this legislation.
