	compensation necessary to liquidate the "existing unfunded accrued
	liability" over a period of years to be determined by the Board of Trustees.
	The "existing unfunded accrued liability" for each employer shall be equal to
	the sum of two liabilities. The first is that portion of the unfunded accrued
	liability for additional benefits payable to each employer's career firefighters
	and career rescue squad workers who are members of the Retirement System
	on June 30, 2009. The "accrued liability contribution" determined on the
	basis of this subdivision shall be added to that determined under

	SECTION 7. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and applies to persons
_	retiring on or after that date.
