Short Title: Upgrade Security Services-Government Complex. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE UPGRADED SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL  
2 SERVICES AT THE STATE LEGISLATURE, STATE GOVERNMENT COMPLEX,  
3 THE EXECUTIVE MANSION, AND THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR'S MANSION  
4 AND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE UPGRADED SECURITY SERVICES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** To upgrade the security services at the State Legislature, State  
8 Government Complex, the Executive mansion, and the Lieutenant Governor's mansion, each  
9 agency exercising control over the State Legislature, State Government Complex, the  
10 Executive mansion, and the Lieutenant Governor's mansion shall purchase and deploy active  
11 and passive security measures, as needed, that are designed to detect weapons and other metal  
12 objects, x-ray technology for the detection of hidden weapons in cases and bags, camera  
13 monitoring systems for visitor and building security, and controlled traffic access to sensitive  
14 areas to prevent attacks by the use of vehicles.

15 **SECTION 2.** To upgrade the emergency medical services at the State Legislature,  
16 State Government Complex, the Executive mansion, and the Lieutenant Governor's mansion,  
17 each agency exercising control over the State Legislature, State Government Complex, the  
18 Executive mansion, and the Lieutenant Governor's mansion shall ensure that at least one  
19 emergency medical technician is on staff, or on call, at each location at all times, that all  
20 employees are trained in first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and that sufficient  
21 numbers of automated external defibrillators are deployed at accessible sites in each location.

22 **SECTION 3.** For the State Legislature, there is appropriated from the General  
23 Fund to the Legislative Services Commission the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to  
24 comply with this act. For the Executive mansion and the Lieutenant Governor's mansion, there  
25 is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety  
26 the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to comply with this act. For the State  
27 Government Complex, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
28 Administration the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to comply with this act.

29 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
