1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO DISTRIBUTE  
3 STATE SURPLUS PROPERTY TO FURBISHERS OF COMPUTERS FOR STUDENTS  
4 IN GRADES KINDERGARTEN THROUGH TWELVE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 143-64.02(2) reads as rewritten:

7 "(2) "Nonprofit tax exempt organizations" means those nonprofit tax exempt  
8 medical institutions, hospitals, clinics, health centers, school systems,  
9 schools, colleges, universities, furbishers of computers for students in grades  
10 kindergarten through 12, schools for the mentally retarded, schools for the  
11 physically handicapped, radio and television stations licensed by the Federal  
12 Communications Commission as educational radio or educational television  
13 stations, public libraries, and civil defense organizations, that have been  
14 certified by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt nonprofit  
15 organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue  
16 Code of 1954."

17 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
