Short Title: City of Greensboro/Motor Vehicle Tax. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF GREENSBORO TO INCREASE ITS MOTOR
3 VEHICLE TAX BY UP TO FIVE DOLLARS.
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5 SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the 1991 Session Laws is repealed.
6 SECTION 2. G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten:
7 "(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax. – Cities and towns may levy a tax of not more than
8 ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per year upon any vehicle resident in the city or
9 town. The proceeds of the tax up to five dollars (\$5.00) may be used for any lawful purpose.
10 The proceeds of these taxes derived from any levy above five dollars (\$5.00) and up to fifteen
11 dollars (\$15.00) shall be used exclusively for local public transportation purposes."
12 SECTION 3. This act applies to the City of Greensboro only.
13 SECTION 4. Section 1 of this act is effective when the City of Greensboro levies a
14 tax under Section 2 of this act. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law. This
15 act does not affect the rights or liabilities of the State, a taxpayer, or another person arising
16 under a statute amended or repealed by this act before the effective date of its amendment or
17 repeal; nor does it affect the right to any refund or credit of a tax that accrued under the
18 amended or repealed statute before the effective date of its amendment or repeal.
