A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONTINUE DISASTER RECOVERY AND RESILIENCY EFFORTS IN HOKE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Hoke County the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2019-2020 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- (1) Eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) for repairs and renovations to the Court Annex related to damage caused by Hurricane Florence.
- (2) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for repairs and renovations to the DMV License Plate Agency related to damage caused by Hurricane Florence.
- (3) Seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) to purchase upgraded VIPER radios for emergency management/first responders.
- (4) Fifty-six thousand dollars (\$56,000) to provide additional support for emergency food distribution during disasters.
- (5) Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to purchase generators for five lift station sites (water utilization).

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
