SECTI	ON 1.(a) The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, in consultation
with the Departme	ent of Information Technology and the Program Evaluation Division of the
General Assembly	, shall study the issue of creating a North Carolina veterans registry. The
purpose of the re	gistry would be to give veterans and their families improved access to
information regard	ling valuable State benefits, programs, and services for veterans and their
families. Upon reg	gistering, a veteran or a family member of a veteran would receive ongoing
communications f	rom the Department about available benefits, programs, and services. A
•	so have the option of leaving the registry.
	ON 1.(b) The Department shall specifically study the following issues:
` '	The information technology needed to create and maintain a veterans registry.
` '	The best ways to summarize and present information about all the State
	benefits, programs, and services for veterans and their families.
1 /	The best ways to communicate this information to registrants.
	The best ways to give notice to veterans and their families about the creation
	of a veterans registry and how to register.
` '	The best ways to allow veterans and their families to opt in or opt out of the
	registry.
(6)	The best ways to maintain the security of the registrants' personal information.

SECTION 1.(c) The Department shall report its findings and recommendations to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on General Government by November 1, 2019.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
