The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of		
Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice, the sum of one million dollars		
(\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be used to develop and		
administer a Prison Software Management Pilot Program (Pilot Program). The purpose of the		
Pilot Program is to work with the most qualified technology vendor to transform the State Prison		
Management Information Systems with software infrastructure and equipment upgrades that will		
enable the Department of Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice, to		
create a new shared database platform to replace the current OPUS System.		
SECTION 2. The requirements to select the qualified technology vendor to create		
the Pilot Program referenced in Section 1 of this act shall include each of the following:
