a residential s	street is (i) a street less than 1 mile in length that does not con-	nect thoroughfares or
major traffic	generators and does not collect traffic from more than 25 dv	welling units or (ii) a
loop street le	ss than 2,500 feet in length. Speed limits set pursuant to this a	act are effective when
appropriate s	igns are erected giving notice of the authorized speed limit.	
Sl	ECTION 2. This act only applies to the City of Durham.	
S	ECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, an	nd applies to offenses

committed on or after that date.
