4	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Section 2(a)(5)(i) of Chapter 112 of the 1961 Session Laws reads as
5	rewritten:
6	"(i) The board shall continue to be composed of eight <u>nine</u> persons and the then members
7	of the board shall continue in office (regardless of the terms for which they were originally
8	appointed) until their successors are elected and qualified, as hereinafter provided."
9	SECTION 3. This section does not affect the terms of office of any person elected
10	in 2020 to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education. Each member of the
11	Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education elected in 2020, or any member appointed
12	to fill a vacancy for a member elected in 2020, shall serve until a successor has been elected and
13	qualified.
14	SECTION 4. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
15	law.
