22	functions of the Committee. The purpose of the study is to examine if revisions are necessary to			
23	provide more effective advice to legislators and enhance the trust of the public. As part of the			
24	study, the Legislative Ethics Committee is directed to study all of the following:

34	the State Ethics Commission shall study the ethical standards for legislators and public servants			
35	and the powers, duties, and functions of the Commission. The purpose of the study is to examine

if revisions are necessary to provide more effective advice to legislators and public servants and
enhance the trust of the public. As part of the study, the Commission is directed to study whether
revisions to the State Government Ethics Act, Chapter 138A of the General Statutes, are needed.
SECTION 3.(b) The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to

5 the 2024 Regular Session of the 2023 General Assembly no later than January 15, 2024.
