 SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors
 - **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2024-2025 fiscal year to inform eligible constituent institutions and members of the public about the intrastate athletic competition required by G.S. 116-40.14, as enacted by this act.
 - **SECTION 3.** Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2024. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
