7	application from a community college requesting that an off-campus instructional site be		
8	recognized as a multicampus center if the off-campus instructional site meets the following

10	(1) The community college has owned and operated the site for mor	e than 10
11		years.	
12	(2	The site is recognized as an off-campus instructional site by the co	ommunity
13		college's accrediting agency.	•

16		or evening program with courses offered in English and Spanish at	the site.

28		ECTION 1.(b) A community college seeking to have an off-campus ins	
29	site meeting the criteria established in subsection (a) of this section recognized as a multicampus		-
30	center shall submit an application to the State Board of Community Colleges no later than		
31	September 1, 2023. The State Board of Community Colleges shall approve an application		
32	meeting the criteria established in subsection (a) of this section no later than January 31, 2024.		
33	SECTION 1.(c) An off-campus instructional site recognized as a multicampus center		
34	pursuant to this section shall continue to be recognized as a multicampus center as long as the		
35	site meets the criteria established in subsection (a) of this section.		
36	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
