A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS OF THE STATE TO AUTHORIZE AN EXCEPTION TO THE AGE RESTRICTION WARNING LABEL FOR ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE SAFETY COURSE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 20-171.15(c) reads as rewritten: "(c) It is unlawful for any parent or legal guardian of a person less than 16 years of age to knowingly permit that person to operate an all-terrain vehicle in violation of the Age Restriction Warning Label affixed by the manufacturer as required by the applicable American National Standards Institute/Specialty Vehicle Institute of America (ANSI/SVIA) design standard. This subsection shall not apply to a safety training course under G.S. 20-171.20 if the instructor determines the weight or height of the person under the age of 16 requires the use of an all-terrain vehicle that does not comply with the Age Restriction Warning." SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
