FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY

This bill has no fiscal impact on the State.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

The bill amends Chapter 144 of the NC General Statutes to add a new section prohibiting all State institutions from using public funds to purchase a flag of the United States or the State of North Carolina unless the flag has been 100 percent manufactured in the United States using materials that have been 100 percent produced in the United States.

The Department of Administration (DOA) processes United States and State of North Carolina flag requests for State agencies. The Department's current practice is to source flags that are 100 percent manufactured and produced in the United States, so this bill would have no fiscal impact on the Department's budget.
