7	(a) The State Human Resources Commission (SHRC) shall do all of the following:					
8		<u>(1)</u>	Regularly assess the educational, experiential, and training requirements			
9			necessary for each position within each State agency, department, and			
10			institution.			
11		<u>(2)</u>	Determine when practical experience and training, such as military service, an			
12			apprenticeship, or a trade school education, rather than a four-year college			
13			degree, is the appropriate qualification for a position.			
14		<u>(3)</u>	Identify jobs for which the educational, experiential, and training			
15			requirements could be reduced from their present level.			
16		<u>(4)</u>	Remove language for a four-year college degree in position descriptions, to			
17			the extent practicable, when they are not necessary for the position.			
18	<u>(b)</u>	Begin	ning October 1, 2025, and then annually thereafter, the SHRC shall report to			
19	the Joint	Legisla	tive Oversight Committee on General Government on its efforts to reduce			
20	barriers to State employment as required by this section."
