A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERMS OF THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE TOWN OF KITTRELL FROM TWO TO FOUR YEARS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of the Charter of the Town of Kittrell, being Chapter 136 of the Private Laws of 1885, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3 That the officers of said town shall consist of a mayor, three commissioners and a constable; and the commissioners shall have power to appoint a secretary and treasurer. Beginning at the regular municipal election in 2025 and quadrennially thereafter, the mayor and the commissioners shall each be elected for four-year terms."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held on or after that date.
