If a public high school does not offer a particular sport, student from that school may participate in the sport at the public high school closest to the student's school that has program in that sport, subject to the terms and condition applicable to a regularly enrolled member of that high school student body, except that the high school may charge reasonable fee for participation to a student who is not enrolled in the high school as established by the local board of education in accordance with G.S. 115C-47(6). 4. A private school or home school student may participate in sport at the base public high school for the student's address subject to the terms and conditions applicable to a regularle enrolled member of that high school's student body. If the student's base public high school does not have a program in particular sport, the student may participate in the sport at the public high school closest to the student's base public high school that has a program in that sport, subject to the terms and conditions applicable to a regularly enrolled member of the high school's student body. The public high school may charge a reasonable fee for participation to a student who is not enrolled in the high school as established by the local board of education in accordance with G.S. 115C-47(6)."
