or local public agency or governmental unit may formally initiate any action to condemn any		
interest in qualifying farmland within a voluntary agricultural district under this Part or an		
enhanced voluntary agricultural district under Part 3 of this Article until such agency has		
requested the local agricultural advisory board established under G.S. 106-739 to hold a public
