G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:</li> <li>"(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the date</li> <li>opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except</li> <li>year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than the Monday closes</li> <li>August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday Closest to June</li> <li>On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that</li> <li>opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow</li> <li>local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August</li> <li>to the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipa</li> <li>makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled closing dat</li> <li>necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days</li> <li>instructional time.
